## Facilities and Estates



### What roles are available within facilities and estates?

Facilities and estates teams play a vital role in the upkeep and maintenance of our hospitals, community buildings, care homes and grounds.

This is particularly important when caring for people who are unwell – buildings that are warm, welcoming and kept to a high standard can have a big impact on a person's experience.

Facilities and estates teams are made up of electricians, plumbers, heating engineers, joiners, painters, housekeepers, caterers and laundry workers.

### Do you have what it takes?

Qualifications required vary per role, but usually ask for a recognised and registered qualification gained via a City and Guilds or similar trade certificate apprenticeship.

Employers may also offer apprenticeships in-house – this means you will work towards your qualification whilst part of a facilities and estates team. These roles will be advertised on the organisation's website or via job websites such as NHS Jobs.

You will develop a range of skills during your training, which include an attention to detail, problem-solving and team working with other tradespeople, clinicians and patients.
