100% of general practices remained open throughout the stated period

19,000 virtual GP appointments by video

225,000 + pieces of PPE delivered to GPs and care homes

99,795 calls to NHS 111 up to end of May 2020 (43% up on the same period for 2019)

3,495 calls from care homes to a specialist helpline

Almost 2,000 'hot hub' appointments for people to be urgently assessed and referred or treated

More than 1,500 home visits and calls made by GPs

4171 calls to the mental health helpline
