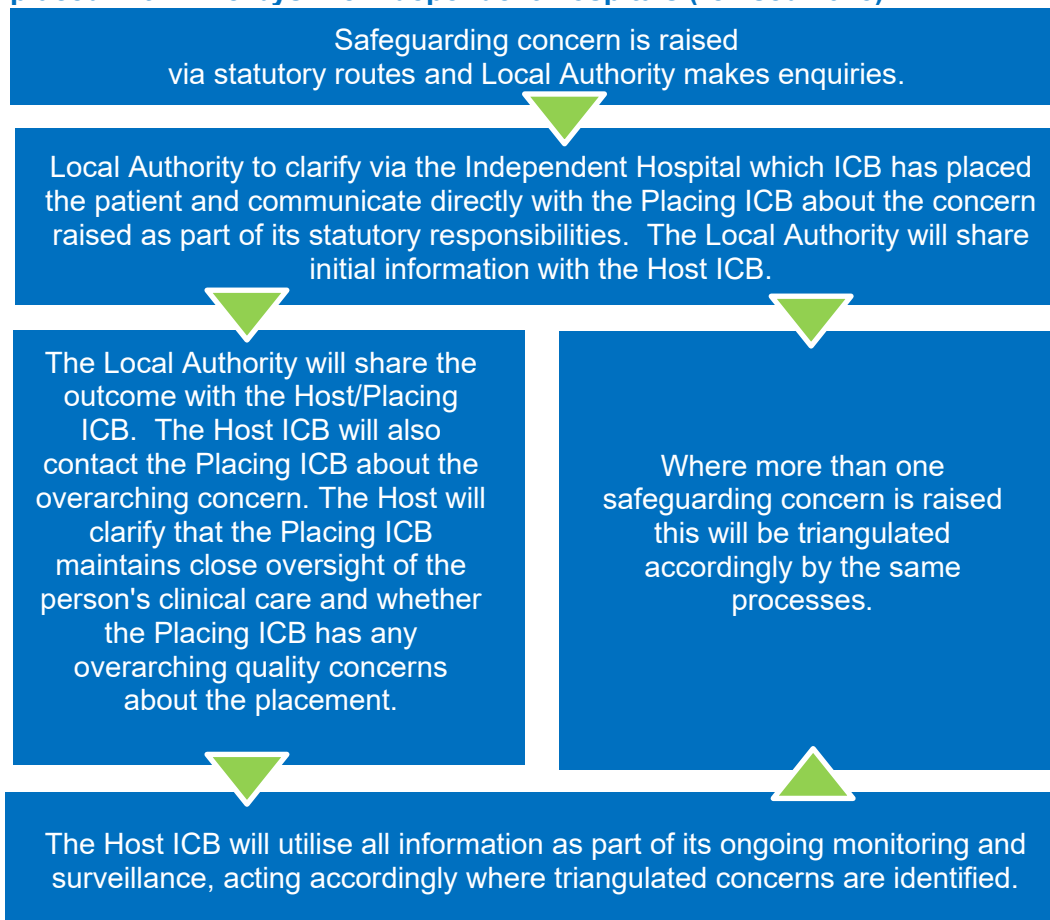


Host ICB flowchart about safeguarding concerns raised for specific people placed within Derbyshire Independent Hospitals (revised 2025)



As the Host ICB for Derbyshire Independent Hospitals, **NHS Derby and Derbyshire ICB does not retain patient identifiable data.** This is held by Placing/Home ICBs.

Please refer to national Host ICB guidance for details on our role. While focused on Learning Disability and/or Autism, the Derbyshire Host Model also includes oversight of Mental Health services.

Placing/Home ICB have oversight for the following

Patient identifiers and all aspects of clinical oversight including concerns and incidents

Placing ICBs/Case Managers will review clinical concerns and direct care for their patients.

ICBs can request Serious Incident Investigations, comment on documentation, care planning and assessments.

Placing ICBS will chair Care and Treatment Reviews/ and attend MDT meetings for the people they place.

Placing/Home ICBs can contact DDICB to raise concerns about overarching quality and care.

NHS Derby and Derbyshire ICB has oversight for overall quality and governance in Derbyshire Independent Hospitals

This includes:

- CQC inspections and action plans (DDICB links closely with the CQC)
- Complaints and patient experience
- Staffing, workforce and training
- Incidents and patient safety
- Independent provider governance and local assurance processes
- Care environment
- Quality visits

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
