



WHAT IS THE MHAW ACTIVITY PROJECT?

A grants programme to be delivered by Derbyshire Mind funded by Derbyshire County Council. The aim of the programme is to enable the delivery of a range of physical activity and wellbeing based sessions across Derbyshire to improve the mental wellbeing of people who may benefit.

- Identify and fill gaps in provision
- Enable support for people to access provision

THE APPLICATION PROCESS



Apply

Applicants will use our streamlined application process to outline their project proposal and funding justification.

Review

Derbyshire Mind will review all applications for funding, successful grants to be awarded to those with:

- Clear plan for effective use of funding
- Funding purpose aligns with MHAW Activity Project end goals
- Funding addresses identified gap in service provision

Fund

Successful grantee invoices Derbyshire Mind for grant total or agreed upon installment. Derbyshire Mind release funds.



ONGOING SUPPORT



Support

Grantees will receive initial onboarding support documents and guidance around review process.

Report

Grantees complete monthly report on project progress, funding use and next steps.

Review

Derbyshire Mind and Grantee have regular ongoing and final review to monitor outcomes of project.
