UPDATE: Direct Access Clinic @ CRHFT

New clinic for suspected cancer at Chesterfield Royal Hospital (CRHFT)

CRH are launching their **Non Site-Specific Direct Access Clinic** from 9th January 2023.

This clinic is suitable for:

- Patients aged >18
- No site-specific red flag symptoms
- Non-specific abdominal pain (>3/52: <6/12)
- Unintentional weight loss (recent and unexplained / >5% weight loss)
- Malignancy suspected in the differential diagnosis
- Have already had results of Vague Symptoms blood panel and CT
- Ongoing concern of undiagnosed NSS malignancy

Please note: patients must have been through the Non Site-Specific pathway but there are still ongoing concerns of cancer
