

## **One Step Back – are we ready for Co-production?**

Co-production is a practical model that involves working in partnership by sharing power between people who draw on care and support, carers, families, and citizens.

Co-production is more powerful when it is embedded with the culture of organisations, and everyone is encouraged and empowered to make it part of their normal practice.

One Step Back is a self-reflecting tool which then creates an action plan to look at how to improve Co-production Culture in regard to self, project, organisation and system.

## Stage 1

Individual Level	Reflect on your own practice
Do you treat people as equal partners, valuing their input?	
Are you empowering individuals to contribute effectively?	
Do you have mutual interactions with both professionals and people with Patient and Public partners?	
Do you feel there is anything that prevents you from doing co-production?	
Service / Project / Team	Evaluate your current service or project
Do you involve Patient and Public partners in design and delivery?	
Is their input given equal weight alongside staff members?	
Do you feel there is anything that prevents your service from doing co-production?	
Organisational Level	Assess the prevailing culture of your organisation
Is co-production part of everyone's day-to- day work within your organisation?	
Are power dynamics shared equally between staff and Patient and Public partners ?	
Are you supported and encouraged to do co-production?	
Do you feel there is anything that prevents your organisation from doing co-production?	
System Level	Assess the Co-production Culture within our system
As a system, do you feel co-production is supported and encouraged?	
Do you feel there is anything that prevents the system from doing co-production?
