Managing deterioration in care homes webinar for primary care

The East Midlands Academic Health Science Network is hosting two webinars taking place on **29 and 30 September** on how care homes in the East Midlands are working to identify the early signs of deterioration in their residents.

Why is this important?

Care home staff are being trained to spot the early signs of deterioration and use the SBARD (Situation Background Assessment Recommendation and Decision) a communications tool to help them report concerns to primary care teams and EMAS. Understanding this tool will bring consistency to communications across the system and allow more residents to receive care through calls and MDTs with an expected reduction in requests for urgent visits.

Who is this session for?

The webinar is suitable for anyone in primary care who works with care homes including: GPs, care coordinators, community matrons, district nurses, advanced care practitioners, physiotherapists and occupational therapists as well as EMAS. It will also be suitable for primary care staff who communicate with care homes regarding care of residents such as for example practice managers, reception supervisors and administration leads.
