What to expect when going for a COVID-19 vaccination



Receive your invitation for the COVID-19 vaccine via your GP practice or the national NHS Vaccination Booking Service.



Book your appointment.



Make a note of your appointment time and date.



You will receive your vaccine through one of the following NHS services:



National Vaccination Centre



GP Practices



Community Venues



Pharmacies



Before you enter the Vaccination Service you will have your temperature checked.



Wear a face covering and clothing that allows us to access your upper arm easily. Don't bring any bags.



Arrive no more than ten minutes before your appointment.



Go to the reception desk to book-in.



Move on to the assessment area and complete your consent form.



Provide your personal details such as: Name, Home Address, NHS Number and GP details.



Read the information provided to answer any questions or queries.



Take a seat and wait 15 minutes after your vaccine (do not drive).



Have your vaccine.



Continue to observe government guidance.



Don't meet with family and friends as there is still a risk you could contract the virus.



Attend your second appointment once scheduled in 12 weeks at the same venue where you received your first dose.
